Experimenting with making her own music on the piano since early childhood, Dr. Lois Veenhoven Guderian began playing her own compositions at school and church when she was 7 years old. Drawing from her ability to arrange and compose music, throughout her career, Lois has continued to compose music for schools, universities, churches, communities, publishers, world-wide broadcasts, private individuals, and the organizations where she has taught. On numerous occasions, Lois has composed new works to fulfill the teaching and learning needs and aesthetic needs of her students and music groups entrusted into her care. Time and again, she has demonstrated her ability to compose in many styles and levels of complexity of music. Her numerous children's songs, choral scores, instrumental music, chamber music works, musicals and songs are in use in schools and churches and published internationally by various publishers and organizations. Lois' works created for performance have been performed in the United States and various places in the world. Her authored textbooks also include hundreds of original pieces and arrangements.
